

## Client: Boortmalt Malting

- Boortmalt is the second largest producer of Malt in Europe. RVC were contracted to remove the redundant heat exchangers and silos from the grain processing plant near Bury St. Edmunds in Suffolk
- The heat exchangers weighed in at around 100 tons in total. Access was made possible by removing the louvered air vents from the side of the factory next to the units. The Heat Exchangers were then partly dismantled by hand then removed mechanically through the side wall of the factory where they were further dismantled and the scrap metals segregated and recycled
- This project was programmed to a very tight timescale of just one week during a 160 hour plant shutdown. The works were completed ahead of schedule
