- This former Gulf petrol station was being demolished to make way for a new Community Health Centre in the centre of Wednesbury, West Midlands. Initially RVC removed the canopy to facilitate access to the fuel tanks, these were then made safe by specialist teams who safely decanted the fuel and removed it from site, the tanks were thoroughly cleaned and left safe (full of water).
- RVC then demolished the remaining kiosk and carried out other enabling works in advance of removing the six fuel tanks. All tanks were emptied of water and a gas free certificate was issued which gave RVC just a 24 hour window in which to excavate the tanks and remove them from site. The site was levelled and left free from debris and rubble ahead of the main contractors construction works with voids backfilled with crushed aggregate from the demolition works
