

## Client: University of Chester – Riverside Innovation Centre

- The building comprising of 2 storey split levels. The scope of works included removing existing office furniture and recycling, uplifting carpet tiles and floor tiles, enabling works removing existing roof lights and cutting away parts of the roof structure. A plant room located on the roof was also demolished. Internally removed windows, internal walls and partitions. Access / Egress was awkward - RVC constructed scaffolding forming a platform across the entrance steps which could enable wheeled skips and be lifted to the ground using a telescopic forklift.
